Airlie Merino Stud has been supplying rams to the New England, Slopes & Plains for 65 years. Our goal has always been to breed well balanced sheep that meet the requirements of both the wool & meat industry. Producing white, well defined, deeply crimped & highly nourished 17-19 micron wools, on large framed, structurally correct, easy care sheep. Alfoxton Stud was founded in 1984, Alfoxton Poll Merino Stud was registered in 2005, with the purchase of 80 poll merino ewes at the Cromarty Stud dispersal.

Alfoxton was one of the original studs chosen to participate in the merino validation project. This was the start of genetic evaluation conducted by sheep genetics to increase rates of genetic gain.

Australian sheep breeding values (ASBV's) describe the genetic merit of individual animals.

Alfoxton sheep are identified as being industry trait leaders for many traits and indexes.

All lambs are tagged and pedigreed at birth, so evaluation of progeny starts at this point.

Our stud flock is fertile, we place great emphasis on maternal traits, positive fat and eye muscle, 300 stud ewes are artificially inseminated and 10 elite ewes are embryo transferred each year.

Sons of Alfoxton 15-430, sold Dubbo National 2017 for \$30,000.00, have topped both Yarrawonga and Roseville Park On-property sales in 2019, selling to a top of \$22,000.00.



APG (ARAKOON Performance Genetics) was founded in 2009 when I was 12 years of age. Striving to produce a modern Merino sheep that excels in my three main breeding objectives. Wool, meat & fertility. In the first 10 years of running the stud only the top Australian genetics were introduced to best breed the merinos suited to our high rainfall summers and harsh cold winters.

In 2015 our first Al program commenced, over the next few years leading sires from Demondrill, Airlie and Nerstane studs were used to enhance the ARAKOON TYPE. In March 2021 our adult ewes average 18.4 μ m at eight months shearing cutting on average 5.3 kg per head at 82 mm, staple strength of 50 and 73.7% yield testing 99.8% comfort factor. Rams annually are sold all over the New England and North West areas Rams again are available from 15 January 2022 for private selections.


Western NSW, Western Victoria and the Riverina to enhance our breeding program through extensive pedigree and performance recording.

Queenlee shore 20,000 merinos in 2021.

Aims: To breed large superfine sheep with good constitution, good bone and covered with stylish, dense, soft handing wool. Our immediate aim is to maintain our average micron of 17.1, crimp frequency and keep improving fleece weight and body weight.

Wool Sold: May 2021 - 289 bales averaged over \$3400/bale. Sales included two 12 bale lines of SUP BLS selling to a top of 1605c/kg.




